Items

- 4 Reading, math, and science supports, including teacher training and/or instructional coaches.
- Athletics and activities. (Coaches, Athletic Directors, C-teams and activity budgets, current pay-forplay fees.)
- 6 Libraries and teacher librarians.
- 7 Music and/or art offerings and supplies and/or instruments.
- 8 Counseling, mental health support, social work, and/or guidance resources.
- 9 Custodial services and building cleaning cycle.
- 10 Custodial services and building cleaning cycle.
- 11 Grounds and fields maintenance.
- 12 Para-educator support services.
- 13 New curriculum resources.
