What: School required immunizations available at **no cost**

- Hepatitis B
- Hib (haemophilus influenza)
- IPV (inactivated poliovirus)
- Varicella (chickenpox)
- PCV 13 (pneumococcal conjugate)
- MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- DTaP/Tdap (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis)
