Study Sessions: Cabinet discussed possible study session topics for the 2014-15 SY.

Knox Space and Moves: Cabinet discussed the office/staff moves taking place throughout the Knox building.

Training Days: Cabinet members reviewed training days set for August and the fall.

Administrative Retreat: Cabinet reviewed the draft agenda for the Aug. 6, 7 and 11 administrative retreat days.

Years of Service Recognition: Cabinet discussed ideas for how to recognize years of service recognition. One idea presented was to print significant milestones on employees' badges. Cabinet agreed this was a good idea. We will begin with the 2015-16 school year since we've already created and distributed badge templates for the 2014-15 school year.

Good Shepherd Move: Cabinet discussed the move of some classrooms to the Good Shepherd Church (5 classrooms) beginning in the 2014-15 school year, including staff coverage. We can begin moving in Aug. 1.

Social Media Policy: Cabinet discussed a timeline for adopting a social media policy. This is an important protective factor for students, and the summer provides an opportunity to train on the policy. Rebecca has research policies from other school districts and these will be used as a foundation for building our policy. Coaches and activities directors need to be able to easily communicate and the policy must provide this option as a safety measure.
