SMALL WORKS ROSTER NOTICE Capital Construction Projects

In accordance with RCW 39.04.155, commonly known as the Common Small Works Roster Procedure, and RCW 28A.335.190, commonly known as the Public School Bid Law, provide that school districts establish a small works roster of qualified contractors who wish to receive bidding information and be considered for performing work on public works projects estimated to cost less than two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000).

Applications are now being received by the Olympia School District Capital Projects Office for capital improvements and construction in the following areas:

asphalt paving	furnishings (office & schools)
cabinets/casework	general contracting
carpentry	hardware
concrete work	HVAC work
data/communications	landscaping
drywall finishing	mechanical systems
earthwork	painting
electrical	playground equipment
equipment (school related)	plumbing
fencing	portables (purchase & placement)
fire alarm systems	roofing
fire protection systems	security systems
flooring systems	utility work

Contractors who wish to be placed on the District's Small Works Roster for 2004-2007 Capital Projects should contact the Facilities and Operations Office, 1113 Legion Way SE, Olympia, WA 98501, (360) 596-8560, for an application form, or **complete the form located on this website and mail or bring the completed application to the above address.**

To be considered for work in 2004, complete applications are due to the above address by April 1, 2004. In order to qualify, contractors must demonstrate the following requirements:

1. Registered contractor in the City of Olympia or the state of Washington.

2. Pay state prevailing wages in accordance with RCW 39.12
3. Provide a Certificate of Insurance
4. Comply with federal, state, and local laws regarding non-discrimination and affirmative action.
