**Who:** Students entering pre-school through 18 years of age

**What:** School required immunizations available at **no cost**

- Hepatitis B
- Hib (haemophilus influenza)
- IPV (inactivated poliovirus)
- Varicella (chickenpox)
- PCV 13 (pneumococcal conjugate)
- MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- DTaP/Tdap (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis)

- ✓ No pre-registration necessary
- ✓ No exemptions/waivers issued
- ✓ Immunizations available on a first-come, first-served basis
