

OATH OF OFFICE

Every person elected or appointed to the office of school director, before entering upon the discharge of the duties thereof, shall take an oath or affirmation to support the Constitution of the United States and the State of Washington and to faithfully discharge the duties of the office according to the best of his/her ability. Forms for this oath of office are available in the office of Educational Service District (ESD) No. 113. A District officer or notary public authorized to administer oaths must certify to this oath and the signature of each new member and file three (3) copies of the signed oath of office with the ESD Superintendent, who shall forward copies to the County Auditor and State Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Every person elected to the office of school director shall begin his or her term of office at the first official meeting of the Board of Directors following certification of the election results.
