
ANNUAL ORGANIZATION MEETING—ORDER OF BUSINESS

In election years the Board shall be organized at the first regular meeting at which the newly elected or re-elected Board members are seated, and at the first regular meeting in December in non-election years. The normal order of business shall be modified by considering the following matters after the approval of the minutes of the previous meeting:

- 1) Welcome.
- 2) Call for nominations for President to serve during the ensuing year.
- 3) Election of a President.
- 4) Assumption of office by the new President.
- 5) Call for nominations for Vice President to serve during the ensuing year.
- 6) Election of Vice President.
- 7) Appoint Board Representative to the Thurston Regional Planning Council.
- 8) Appoint Board Representative to the Educational Foundation Board.

The Board's Washington State School Directors' Association Legislative Representative shall be elected for a two-year term by the Board at the last regular meeting in June of even-numbered years. It is the responsibility of the Legislative Representative to attend Washington State School Directors' Association Legislative Assemblies, conveying local views and concerns to that body and participating in the formulation of state legislative programs. The Legislative Representative shall monitor proposed school legislation and inform the Board of the issues.
