

**ADOPTION AND AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS AND POLICIES**

Policy proposals and suggested amendments or revisions to existing policies will be read and discussed by the members of the Board. Unless it is deemed by the Board that it would be in the best interests of the District to take immediate action, a vote for adoption will take place not earlier than the next succeeding regular or special meeting of the Board.

Staff members and other citizens may be invited to present oral or written statements as an order of business before a vote is taken on a proposed policy. It is the Board's intent that citizens discuss matters relating to new or amended bylaws or policies with the Superintendent or other staff members before bringing them to the attention of the Board.

Correspondence should be directed to the Secretary of the Board.

Bylaws proposals and suggested amendments, or revisions of existing bylaws, shall be by majority vote of members present. The call for proposed additions, amendments or revisions shall have been described in writing.

**SUSPENSION**

Bylaws of the Board shall be subject to suspension only upon a majority vote of the members of the Board present at a meeting in the call for which the proposed suspension has been described in writing.
