

RELEASE OF INFORMATION CONCERNING SEXUAL OFFENDERS

The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to release relevant and necessary information regarding sex offenders when the release of such information is deemed in the interest of public safety. This authority is granted in accord with RCW 4.24.550 which provides immunity from civil liability in the release of information regarding a person convicted of a sex offense, or a juvenile found to have committed a sex offense.

The Superintendent or designee may disseminate this information under either of the following conditions:

- 1) Receipt of a specific request from a law enforcement agency that information be disseminated to students and/or parents. In every case where students are notified, parents should be notified as soon as feasible.
- 2) Receipt of the actual notifications. The District may duplicate the documents and will distribute them in the form received from the law enforcement agency.
