
COMPLIANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING SEX DISCRIMINATION

It is the policy of the Board that the District be maintained in compliance with the requirements of Title IX, RCW 28A.85, rules adopted by the State Board of Education, and regulations of the Superintendent of Public Instruction. The Superintendent is directed to designate a District compliance officer(s) who shall promulgate rules, regulations and procedures designed to achieve the following:

- 1) An initial and continuing notification to the District's students, student's parents, employees, and other organizations and media as required by law, of the District's nondiscrimination policy.
- 2) Provision of grievance procedure to investigate and resolve complaints alleging discrimination.
- 3) Provision of procedure for an annual evaluation of the District program with subsequent appropriate modification and remediation.
- 4) Compliance with all sections of Washington Administrative Code pertaining to discrimination.
- 5) Maintenance of appropriate records.
- 6) Compilation and submission of required reports.
