
FOOD SERVICE PROGRAMS

It shall be the policy of the District to offer a food service program in each of the District's schools. The cost of meals to students shall be reviewed periodically and set by the Board. The District will try to achieve a "break-even" basis for the program while keeping student costs as low as consistent with that objective. Free and reduced-price breakfasts and lunches will be provided in accordance with state and federal guidelines.

Sales in the food service operation shall be made by cash, pre-numbered tickets or computerized pre-payment systems. Receipts shall be deposited daily in a local bank by Food Services staff and transferred at least once a month to the Thurston County Treasurer by District business office personnel.
