SMALL WORKS ROSTER NOTICE Capital Construction Projects

In accordance with RCW 39.04.155, commonly known as the Common Small Works Roster Procedure, and RCW 28A.335.190, commonly known as the Public School Bid Law, provide that school districts establish a small works roster of qualified contractors who wish to receive bidding information and be considered for performing work on public works projects estimated to cost less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000).

In addition to completed applications, the contractors must demonstrate the following requirements:

1. Registered contractor in the City of Olympia
2. Pay state prevailing wages in accordance with RCW 39.12
3. Provide a Certificate of Insurance
4. Comply with federal, state, and local laws regarding non-discrimination and affirmative action.
