Snow Bulletin 2020-21 School Year

Hello OSD Families.

Every year, inevitably, snow or severe weather conditions lead to a delay in start times or the closure of our school buildings. This year, with most of our students learning remotely, we have modified plans for school schedule changes.

Important: As most students are learning this year remotely, **even when start times are delayed or schools are closed due to inclement weather, remote learning will continue on regular schedule.** The advantage to transitioning to a remote learning day, as opposed to canceling school, is to alleviate the need for makeup days at the end of the academic calendar in June.

Students should be prepared for potential school schedule changes by making a habit of having their Chromebooks at home and charged every day.

Communications Protocol

- Families will be notified of school schedule changes via email, phone and text by our school district notification system. Any school closure or change in school schedule will also be posted as an alert that will pop up on the school district website (http://osd.wednet.edu), as well as on all school websites. School schedule changes are also announced on the district's social media platforms and are shared with local radio and/or television stations.
- If school is open, but you think it would be unsafe for your child to attend, school officials will accept your judgment and it will be treated as an excused absence.
- Be sure your student's information is up-to-date in Skyward Family Access so you do not miss an important school schedule change message.

School Building Closure

- All in-person, on-campus learning and activities are canceled for the day.
- Remote learning continues on a regular schedule for all students scheduled for distance learning on that day. Students scheduled for hybrid in-person learning will shift to their school's regular distance learning schedule with their classroom teacher.
- If a majority of families and staff at a school do not have power, remote learning will be canceled. If individual families are without power and the student has not already completed their Daily Check-In, if possible, they should call the school to record their student check-in.
- No child care.
- No meal distribution (includes school and community sites)
- No out-of-district transportation.

School Late Start

- All elementary students who are attending school for in-person hybrid learning will start school on-site two hours
 late. Buses will pick up students two hours late. AM and PM preschool will not take place in person on campus;
 rather, they will shift to distance learning with their classroom teacher.
- Remote learning continues on a regular schedule for all students scheduled for distance learning on that day.
- Small in-person **morning only** learning groups are canceled. Small groups that meet all day start two hours late. Small groups that meet in the afternoon only are not impacted.

- No out-of-district transportation.
- Child care starts 2 hours late.
- Unless otherwise notified, athletics and other after-school extracurricular activities will continue on a normal schedule. Families that self-transport students to extracurricular activities may continue to do so at their own discretion.
- Grab-and-go meals will be distributed at all schools, community, and child care sites on the same schedule as usual (no hot meals at child care sites).

Snow Routes

On rare occasions, weather conditions may make it necessary to modify school bus routes. When that occurs, the district and media outlets will announce the use of "snow routes" or "emergency routes." Emergency routes are attached to this letter and are posted on the <u>district website</u>.

- No out-of-district transportation.
- Students in special education programs who are normally picked up at their home and whose addresses are affected by snow routes will be called by the district Transportation Department. Families will need to bring their students to the identified snow route bus stop or transport them directly to school.

At other times, weather conditions may require schools to close early. In that event, the normal busing sequence will be followed; returning high school and middle school students home first, followed by elementary students approximately one to two hours later. Please instruct your child what to do should there be an early school closure when you are not home during the school day.

Parents are also asked to remind students to be especially careful and to dress appropriately when walking or waiting for a bus during bad weather.

It is our hope that weather conditions do not disrupt transportation and schools. However, our most critical concern is the safety and welfare of our students.
