

# Charter for Olympia School District District Dress Code Advisory Committee

<b>Authorized by</b>	Superintendent
<b>Charge</b>	To develop recommendations to the school board for a district-wide non-biased dress code policy.
<b>Time Frame</b>	September 18, 2018: First meeting from 6:30-8:30 PM 2 <sup>nd</sup> Meeting: Date and Time TBD 3 <sup>rd</sup> Meeting: Date and Time TBD 4 <sup>th</sup> Meeting (if necessary): Date and Time TBD  Recommendation to the School Board on October 22, 2018.
<b>Membership</b>	Principals and Schools will solicit volunteers and determine committee members: Committee members: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 8 Students (4 middle School, 4 high School)</li> <li>● 4 Educational Staff (2 middle school, 2 high school)</li> <li>● 2 administrators (1 middle school, 1 high school)</li> <li>● 6 Family Representatives* (3 middle, 3 High)</li> </ul> <small>*Prefer that 1 to 2 family representatives also have elementary age children in the district</small>
<b>Facilitation</b>	School Board Director Leslie Huff with Co-facilitator chosen at first meeting
<b>Approach</b>	The committee will examine existing policies and explore best practices as they relate to dress code with the goal to develop a dress code that is free of gender and/or racial bias to recommend to the school board. The chairs will be responsible for facilitating each meeting, communicating on progress and presenting the recommendations to the board in October. Recommendations must come in writing to the board, but may also be presented in person by members at the meeting.
