## TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION

The District shall make available to eligible students the opportunity to participate in Traffic Safety Education. A fee shall be assessed to cover those costs which are not reimbursed by state funds.

The Board directs the Superintendent to implement procedures dealing with program supervision; curriculum development; student enrollment criteria, including but not limited to grade level of student, age of student and enrollment status of student; student progress; collection and refunding of student fees, including provisions for accruing money for future traffic safety program needs or refunding students when student fees exceed the un-reimbursed cost of the programs; and notice of the availability of fee waivers or reductions.
