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**ATHLETIC CODE FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

Participating in athletic programs, including cheer, drill/dance, is a privilege, not a right, and involves teamwork, responsibility and self-discipline. The Olympia School District is committed to promoting healthy and active lifestyles, personal development and successful performance of our high school students. This policy is designed to assist students who participate in athletic programs, including cheer, drill/dance, to be safe, responsible, healthy and successful. All students who choose to participate in athletic programs are expected, and required, to set a positive example for others through their conduct and promotion of a positive school culture, holding to high academic and behavior standards, and is free from harassment, violence, alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.

The Superintendent will develop procedures designed to provide specific requirements and regulations to be followed by all high school students participating in athletics, including cheer, drill/dance.
