

STUDENT HEALTH

The Superintendent will arrange for appropriate and required health services to be provided to all students. Such services will include, but not be limited to:

- 1) The maintenance of student health records;
- 2) The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- 3) Consulting services of a qualified health specialist for staff, students and parents;
- 4) Vision and hearing screening;
- 5) Monitoring of immunization records; and,
- 6) Safe administration of required medication.
