BUSINESS INVOLVEMENT IN OUR SCHOOLS

It is the obligation of the District to protect the welfare of students and staff and the integrity of the learning environment. School-Business relationships, based on sound principles, can contribute to the quality of education. School-Business relationships should be structured in accordance with the following:

- 1) Business involvement must support the goals and objectives of the schools.
- Schools and educators will hold sponsored and/or donated classroom or resource materials to the same standards used for the selection and purchase of curriculum materials.
- 3) Business involvement programs will not limit the discretion of schools and teachers in the use of sponsored materials.
- 4) Promotion/distribution of materials or opportunities must be of educational value to students and/or their families.
- 5) Within any school building or District facility, identification of any commercial enterprise, whether for sponsor recognition or as a result of permissible involvement, will be for identification purposes only.
