DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS TO STUDENTS AND PROMOTIONS BY COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

It is the intent of the District to cooperate with community and service organizations that improve the community and promote its welfare. The schools will cooperate with these organizations in every way consistent with good educational practices. As education of the child is the primary purpose of the schools, instructional time should not be taken from teachers and pupils to promote community activities, however commendable, except as such use of pupil and teacher time shall be adjudged as complementary to the educational program.
