The Board of Directors recognizes that the broad use of telecommunications in the work place has changed the way employees gather and share ideas. Today, staff members are connected to a global community where the use of electronic information systems provides a variety of means for communicating with others. Use of these new tools and systems provides many new opportunities for employees and requires new responsibilities, as well.

All use of electronic, networked information systems must support education and be consistent with the mission of the District. The District reserves the right to prioritize use and access to the system.

The Board directs the Superintendent to develop appropriate procedures for the use of the District's electronic information systems by all District employees.
